THE PROMISES OF GOD

His Presence

Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go. *Joshua 1:9*

No evil shall be allowed to befall you, no plague come near your tent. ¹¹ For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways. *Psalms 91:10-11*

But whoever listens to me will dwell secure and will be at ease, without dread of disaster. *Proverbs 1:33*

Keep your life free from love of money, and be content with what you have, for he has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." ⁶ So we can confidently say, "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear; what can man do to me?" *Hebrews 13:5-6*

Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. *Isaiah 41:10*

His Protection

The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear him, and delivers them. *Psalms 34:7*

His Provision

But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. *Matthew 6:33*

He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things? *Romans 8:32*

And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus. *Philippians 4:19*

His Peace

Great peace have those who love your law; nothing can make them stumble. *Psalms 119:165*

You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you. *Isaiah 26:3*

Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. *John 14:27*

His Forgiveness

For you, O Lord, are good and forgiving, abounding in steadfast love to all who call upon you. *Psalms 86:5*

He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities. ¹¹ For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him; ¹² as far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us. *Psalms 103:10-12*

And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. ³¹ Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. ³² Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you. *Ephesians 4:30-32*

His Guidance

Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path. *Psalms 119:105*

Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. ⁶ In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths. *Proverbs 3:5-6*

If anyone's will is to do God's will, he will know whether the teaching is from God or whether I am speaking on my own authority. *John 17:7*

His Strength

Wait for the LORD; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the LORD! *Psalms 27:14*

but they who wait for the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint. *Isaiah 40:31*

Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need. *Hebrews 4:16*

His Victory

No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it. *1 Corinthians 10:13*

But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁵⁸ Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain. *1 Corinthians 15:57-58*

I can do all things through him who strengthens me. *Philippians 4:13*

SALVATION

Sin

As it is written: "None is righteous, no, not one. *Romans 3:10*

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. *Romans 3:23*

Therefore, just as sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men because all sinned. *Romans 5:12*

Christ Died for Us

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. *John 3:16*

But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. *Romans 5:8*

For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit. *1 Peter 3:18*

Salvation Only in Him

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." *John 14:6*

And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved. *Acts 4:12*

For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,⁶ who gave himself as a ransom for all, which is the testimony given at the proper time. *1 Timothy 2:5-6*

Must Repent

No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish. *Luke 13:3*

Repent therefore, and turn again, that your sins may be blotted out. *Acts 3:19*

Repent, therefore, of this wickedness of yours, and pray to the Lord that, if possible, the intent of your heart may be forgiven you. *Acts 8:22*

But declared first to those in Damascus, then in Jerusalem and throughout all the region of Judea, and also to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, performing deeds in keeping with their repentance. *Acts 26:20*

Must Receive

But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, *John 1:12*

Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him. *John 3:36*

Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me. *Revelation 3:20*

Not By Works

Now to the one who works, his wages are not counted as a gift but as his due.⁵ And to the one who does not work but believes in him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is counted as righteousness. *Romans 4:4-5*

For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God,⁹ not a result of works, so that no one may boast. *Ephesians 2:8-9*

He saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit. *Titus 3:5*

Assurance of Salvation

My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.²⁸ I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. *John 10:27-28*

And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ. *Philippians 1:6*
And this is the testimony, that God gave us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.¹² Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.¹³ I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God that you may know that you have eternal life.

THE WORD OF GOD

Inspiration

All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,¹⁷ that the man of God may be competent, equipped for every good work. *2 Timothy 3:16-17*

Hear It

So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ. *Romans 10:17*

Read It

Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear, and who keep what is written in it, for the time is near. *Revelation 1:3*

Study It

Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth. *2 Timothy 2:15*

Meditate On It

This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. *Joshua 1:8*

Practice these things, immerse yourself in them, so that all may see your progress. *1 Timothy 4:15*

Memorize It

How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding it according to your word.¹⁰ With my whole heart I seek you; let me not wander from your commandments!¹¹ I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you. *Psalms 119:9-11*

Obey It

But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. *James 1:22*

So whoever knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, for him it is sin. *James 4:17*

CHRISTIAN LIVING

Christ the Center

I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. *John 15:5*

For the love of Christ controls us, because we have concluded this: that one has died for all, therefore all have died;¹⁵ and he died for all, that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for him who for their sake died and was raised. *2 Corinthians 5:14-15*

Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men,²⁴ knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ. *Colossians 3:23-24*

Holy Spirit

Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own,²⁰ for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body. *1 Corinthians 6:19-20*

For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body - Jews or Greeks, slaves or free - and all were made to drink of one Spirit. *1 Corinthians 12:13*

But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.¹⁷ For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do. *Galatians 5:16-17*

Confess Sins Daily

I confess my iniquity; I am sorry for my sin. *Psalms 38:18*

Whoever conceals his transgressions will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy. *Proverbs 28:13*

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. *1 John 1:9*

Surrender (Dedication)

Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions. ¹³ Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness. *Romans 6:12-13*

I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. ² Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. *Romans 12:1-2*

So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God. *1 Corinthians 10:31*

Prayer

And whatever you ask in prayer, you will receive, if you have faith. *Matthew 21:22*

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. ⁷ And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. *Philippians 4:6-7*

And whatever we ask we receive from him, because we keep his commandments and do what pleases him. *1 John 3:22*

Fellowship

And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. *Acts 2:42*

Not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near. *Hebrews 10:25*

That which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. *1 John 1:3*

Witness

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age. *Matthew 28:19-20*

For whoever is ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him will the Son of Man also be ashamed when he comes in the glory of his Father with the holy angels. *Mark 8:38*

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth. *Acts 1:8*

That is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. ²⁰ Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. *2 Corinthians 5:19-20*

DOCTRINE

Sin

Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor men who practice homosexuality, ¹⁰ nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God. *1 Corinthians 6:9-10*

Death & Hell

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. *Romans 6:23*

And just as it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment. *Hebrews 9:27*

But as for the cowardly, the faithless, the detestable, as for murderers, the sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars, their portion will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulfur, which is the second death. *Revelation 21:8*

Inspiration

And we also thank God constantly for this, that when you received the word of God, which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men but as what it really is, the word of God, which is at work in you believers. *1 Thessalonians 2:13*

It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh is no help at all. The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life. *John 6:63*

Salvation

Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth. *John 17:17*

To open their eyes, so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me. *Acts 26:18*

Since you have been born again, not of perishable seed but of imperishable, through the living and abiding word of God; *1 Peter 1:23*

Second Coming

For it is written, "As I live, says the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God." ¹² So then each of us will give an account of himself to God. *Romans 14:11-12*

For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil. *2 Corinthians 5:10*

For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, ¹² training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, ¹³ waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ. *Titus 2:11-13*

And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire. *Revelation 20:15*
